PAASCU LEVEL III ACCREDITED

Lower Level (Elementary) and Higher Level (Secondary) This program caters to the academic needs of learners through the non-graded, self-paced, and modular system of learning. The program allows each learner to complete the set of skills required for each subject based on his/her own space without the usual time frame.

The learners' progress in a given subject area is determined by their personal capability to learn, coupled with efforts they actually exert, and conditioned by their degree of responsibility and maturity. Learners learn that competition is within themselves and their capabilities are not measured based on others.

Regular Program

PRE-SCHOOL

Pre-Kinder

Offered to children who are four years old, this level serves as a preparatory stage before they go to Kinder. Learners are given the opportunity to connect what they know and what they are learning in a fun yet educational way.

Kinder (YS 1)

Best for children who are five years old, this academically-rich Kindergarten program includes Language, Reading, Math, Arts, PE, and Christian Living Education. Learners are provided with opportunities to appreciate learning and enhance their skills in numbers, reading, and communication before they enter the first grade.

ELEMENTARY

YS 2 - YS 4 (Grade 1 to Grade 3)

Learners in these levels are still in the formative years of learning. They go to school every day and are guided by their learning facilitators in accomplishing their modular activities.

YS 5 - YS 7 (Grade 4 - Grade 6)

Learners in these levels are already considered semi-independent and are given the opportunity to gradually develop a degree of independence in accomplishing their modules and other learning tasks as they come to school every day. Learning facilitators supervise the learning activities in the learning station. Learners who have mastered the required skills ahead of others are allowed to move to the next set of modules. Highly motivated learners are allowed to advance per subject within an academic year, provided that they have exhibited mastery of the required skills (vertical promotion).

JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL

YS 8 - YS 11 (Grade 7 - Grade 10)

Learners go to school every day and do their modules independently. Learning facilitators supervise the learning activities in the learning station. Highly motivated learners who have mastered the required skills ahead of others are allowed to move to the next set of modules and advance in the subject within an academic year, provided that they have exhibited mastery of the required skills (vertical promotion).

- 3 Report Card from the Previous Grade Level/Year Level (FI38)
- 4 Original ESC Certificate (If ESC Grantee)
- 5 Admission Fee of Php 600.00

- 1 Alien Certificate Registration (ACR I-Card)
- 2 Passport (information page and visa page)
- 3 Study Permit Issued by the Bureau of Immigration
- 4 Certificate of Filipino Citizenship or Philippine Passport (for dual citizenship applicants)

- 2 Grade Level and Grading System Explanation from the Current School
